

Infant Mortality


From the survey results we can see a significant drop in the number of infant deaths in a span of 5 years.


The mortality rate has 0.3%

The highest mortality rate is seen in Madhya Pradesh (16.4) and lowest being Kerala (1.9)


On further research we found out that amongst those deaths the number 7.106 avg the male by






Other than the basic check-ups the babies are give immunization shots









- 3) Hospital provides her with the subsciribtion option.
- 4 Once she selects for the subscription, she is educated by the doctors/nurse on labout the kit.
- 5 Goes back home and starts using the kit.
- 6 Comes back to the hospital for regular check-ups.
 Where the subscription is upgraded.

O Kit's elements are ever produced in factory and assembled

A batch (consisting of 20 units) is delivered to the Hospital monthly.

On alternate months, the upgradable elements are delivered \$\$ to the Hospital.

These kits and upgrades are then under the pharmacy's care, and are handed out based on prescriptions.


IDEAS

- Make Pedialyte or Infalyte in doses packed & ready to use



- Baby might suffocate




Nail scissors

Abhilasha Narayan Onco-gynec & mother


Abhilasha(37) is a working mother of a 5 year old boy.

Rekha Shivanna Helper


Rekha(27) is a house helper and an expecting mother. Uses a old Nokia keypad phone.
